The *On Course Foundation* has been created to offer injured men and women (initially from the UK and subsequently from the US), who are retired or still serving in the military, the opportunity to play golf and/or work within the industry not just today but for many years to come.

With this progression, *On Course* will provide a unique opportunity for a number of our injured service and ex-service personnel to be part of our work in the golf environment.

Launched on Friday, 2nd July 2010 at Windsor Castle, wounded servicemen and women are invited to play a round of golf on the Royal Household Golf Course by invitation from the *On Course Foundation*.

- To provide specific training courses within the golfing world in order to facilitate employment in the industry
